A School for Rights is a school where youth are aware of their rights and of the right's of their peers. The school gives children's rights and global citizenship a place in the everyday school culture: in lessons, policies and activities. We provide tailor-made coaching to make this happen. Together with the school, the coach looks for an approach tailored to the individual school realities.

INITIAL PHASE

At the start of the project, we analyse the initial situation by questioning both students and teachers. This covers a wide range of topics linked to the schools: health, sustainability, participation, equal treatment and diversity, family involvement, privacy, quality education, leisure and culture. We discuss the results and develop a tailored approach together.
